**Monday, April 8, 2019 Meeting Minutes**

The meeting began at 6:02 p.m. and Krista led us with a prayer.

**Principal's Report (Lynn Wilt)**

- Spoke to Shelly – used uniform sale (Saturday 7/20 drop off, Sunday 7/21 sale 12-2): discussed separate tables – man your own; concerns with lack of participation or frustration buying. Keep “free item” table closer to checkout; have several people working to roam to keep an eye out. ADD TO TITAN: NEED HELP, IF YOU CAN HELP YOU GET FIRST CHOICE SHOPPING
- Ice cream social for NEW/incoming JPIIA families 7/28 1pm-2pm in cafeteria

**President's Report (Shelly Junuzovic)**

- Not present; report given to Ms. Wilt prior to meeting. Be aware box tops – digital from now on. Like shoparoo... you'll scan the box top into an app, will need receipt as well.

**Vice President & Secretary's Report (Krista Roach)**

- Skate party 4/23 6:30-8:30. NEED TO MAKE FLYERS AND DISTRIBUTE TO EACH SCHOOL FOR THEM TO SEND HOME

**Treasurer's Report (Judy Sampson)**

- Budget – no coupon books have been sold at fish fry. About 30 left (Judy has down 34 left). Melissa and Pam have them; none in office.
- Need to push Kroger (well over earning what was anticipated)
- Need to push shoparoo – very easy, and less coming in this year for some reason
- Need to push coca cola (Judy enters for us – Julie asked if 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders can help enter those in – YES – helps with services, parish life... – beginning of school and Christmas = double points!! Need to really use that time
- MOD – recent issue with Manual. NEED TO FOLLOW UP ON MOST RECENT DINE OUT CHECK (not yet received)
- This school year, made 15000, spent 5000; still have 2400 to pay for 8<sup>th</sup> grade expenses
- room parent role eliminated; Julie had met w/ teachers – all ok with coordinating needs for parties. – question – still need a contact person so parents can coordinate teacher gifts....
- Field day - ran by 7<sup>th</sup> graders, Friday 5/17/19
- No teachers have requested funds for anything in particular for next year
- 8<sup>th</sup> graders Kings Island trip Friday 5/10/19
- 11095 expenses for 2019-2020
- Budget motioned Judy, 2<sup>nd</sup> Krista
- Lynn suggestion to school board and others: get away from flyers that say PTO “BOARD” meeting – intimidated, ‘only board’ – make it feel more inclusive.
- Possible treasurer for next school year, but not til 9/2019.... Judy agreeable to help until then.
- Lynn has list of suggested families that may be of help to PTO. She recommend we message them in July to explain we are “changing the way PTO format is... we need you to be part of making the decisions, or need your opinion...need fresh ideas”

### Major Fundraising Coordinator's Report (Pam Demling transitioning out; Melissa and Bob Goens transitioning in)

- **Melissa and Bob** : several idea for 2019-2020 major fundraising.
  - family oriented – try painting: Pinot's Palette has been contacted, awaiting call back (they bring everything (tables and all...)). Same idea, but a little less expensive: Paula Edwards – did a private class at a JPIIA parent home – talented audience... what if PTO bought the stuff/or ask for someone to donate them (brushes, canvas, paint)... family pricing and individual pricing. Lynn said to consider the finished product as a Christmas gift?
  - Family night at Main Event – 20% (similar to restaurants). Sunday/Tuesday/Wednesday nights. Suggested FALL and SPRING. JPIIA PTO has to manage it and collect money/receipts... can collect ALL receipts (concession, bowling, etc.). (Pam mentioned Martha doing something similar at the YMCA).
  - Malibu Jacks – similar – 11p-6a - \$3500 lock in ... more of an event we pay for, not a fundraiser.
  - Foam Warrioriz – nerf gun similar to laser tag. where CiCi's pizza used to be, by Feeders supply
  - Bingo: maybe toy bingo in December – when you win bingo – you go up and choose a toy prize... need pull tabs... but need the workers.
  - Taste and talent of JPIIA (taste done in past at JPIIA – not well attended, but talent has gone well. Considered Hispanic population – authentic Latino food, share recipes). Talent – “featuring former pastor Fr. Bill” ...
  - Sell raffles for a car... Buy a car (early 70s corvette) – put in \$5000 to be sure it's safe, nice, etc. Drive the car to all the picnics – sell raffles.... Per Pam must say EXACTLY what you are raffling, or will be fined. Parish wise – good idea per Lynn. Can limit # of sold tickets... discussed other options besides car
  - Comedy night (less work than trivia) was 1/26/19 this year.... But less \$\$\$ coming in than trivia
  - Trivia night 11/10/18 this past year.... Keep in fall like it has been due to being so successful
  - Keep in mind Bellarmine can earn service hours – utilize them. If one shot event, like Carnival, do NOT need Honor Thy Child because there are other adults w/ that training who will be present. Must be 21 to WORK over 21 events.... But may use under 21 to set up or tear down.
  - Texas Roadhouse night for a dine out night
  - Per Lynn: MUST GET DATES for any events for 2019-2020 school year AT NEXT MEETING – TO PLACE ON SCHOOL/PARISH CALENDAR.....
  - Pam encouraged that we take woohoo cart around one more time before end of school.
